

***NEW YORK STATE MATHEMATICS HONOR SOCIETY  
HONORARY MEMBERSHIP***

In the constitution under Article VI, Section 1 addresses Honorary Membership. The following criteria will be followed

- Any elected student or faculty advisor of a registered local chapter in good standing can nominate an alumni or adult for honorary membership
- A maximum of one honorary membership may be granted each year from each chapter
- The nominee should possess the qualifications below:
  1. Be an effective mathematics teacher. Evidence could include student letters of support, percentage of students scoring high on external examinations such as the Regents, PSAT, SAT, ACT, or in competitions such as math leagues or fairs.
  2. Be a leader in mathematics education. Evidence could include articles in refereed journals, presentations to professional mathematics educators, positions in local, state, national mathematics education organizations, or awards for teaching from recognized mathematics organizations.
  3. Be a recognized mathematics scholar. Evidence could include articles in refereed journals, collegiate or recognized organization awards or positions.
