

NYSCEA DELEGATE

The NYSCEA Senior Delegate is chosen by the President to serve for a term of one year, and is a member of both the Executive Board and the Assembly for that year. The Senior Delegate may be reappointed at the discretion of the next incoming President.

The Senior Delegate is responsible for attending the NYSCEA meetings which are usually held on Fridays in the Albany area three times per year. Reports of these meetings should be given at each AMTNYS Executive Board and Assembly held throughout the year. The Senior Delegate is also responsible for sending AMTNYS news and information to NYSCEA for its reports and/or newsletters.

The President-Elect usually serves as the Junior Delegate to NYSCEA. The President and President-elect may attend the Presidents' Sub-Council meetings (usually held on Fridays). The Delegates attend the Legislative meeting and Delegate Assembly (usually held on Saturdays).

The Delegates represent AMTNYS when:

1. approving NYSCEA policy,
2. presenting and acting upon resolutions,
3. supporting action taken by NYSCEA affiliated members,
4. deciding upon organizations requesting membership in NYSCEA.

The President and both Delegates have the option of attending the NYSCEA Leadership Conference, if one is conducted.
