STEM COMMITTEE

The chairperson is chosen by the President to serve for a term of one year, and is a member of the Assembly for that year. The chairperson may be reappointed to this committee at the discretion of the next incoming President.

Committee Responsibilities

- 1. At least (4) additional AMTNYS members will be chosen, one (1) each from Elementary, Middle School, High School, College levels. It is highly recommended that each member be an active classroom teacher. The total # of committee members may increase as needs arise, but should never be less than 5.
- 2. The Committee Chair and AMTNYS President will appoint up to 3 committee members to be the AMTNYS delegation to the NYS STEM Education Collaborative, and each will have a vote in that Collaborative.
- 3. Members will be appointed for a period of 1 year, much the same way the AMTNYS president creates annual appointments.
- 4. The members of this committee will meet as needed (face-to-face; conference call; over the web) to gather pertinent information and will inform the AMTNYS leadership of STEM activities around the state,
- 5. The members of this committee will, whenever possible, provide presentations for regional and statewide conferences for all the STEM Ed Collaborative Associations and their partners.
- 6. AMTNYS will support the previous activities by providing a sufficient current budget line.
