

SUMMER WORKSHOP ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The chairperson is chosen by the President to serve for a term of one year, and is a member of the Assembly for that year. The chairperson may be reappointed to this committee at the discretion of the next incoming President.

The Summer Workshop Advisory Committee is responsible for long-range planning and policy recommendations relative to the Annual AMTNYS Summer Workshop.

Committee Responsibilities

1. Maintain a file on one or two of the most recent workshops which includes a program and the final report of the workshop chairperson.
2. Regularly update the Summer Workshop Handbook and its listing of future hosts.
3. Investigate potential sites and recommend a suitable location and chairperson to the President at or before the next Executive Board meeting following the Annual Meeting approximately one and one-half years in advance of the summer workshop. The President will act on the committee's recommendation with the approval of the Executive Board and will extend an invitation to the college.
4. Report the site selected to the Assembly at its next meeting.
